1. The institution has signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement for the Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students. The institution has used, or intends to use no less than 50% of the funds received under Section 18004 (a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide emergency financial aid grants to students.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students is \$69,348.
3. The total amount of emergency financial aid grants distributed to students as the date of this fund report is \$39,240.
4. The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, and thus eligible to receive emergency financial aid grants under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act , as of the date of this report is 24.
5. The total number of students who have received an emergency financial aid grant under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the date of this fund report is 22.
6. The methods used by the institution to determine which students receive under section 18004(a)(1) of the Cares Act are provided in Attachment A.
7. Any instructions, directions or guidance provided by the institution to the students concerning the emergency financial aid grants are provided in Attachment B. Students also received text messages, phone calls and email communications in regards to the emergency financial aid grant.
